## 1. Designation and object of SERVICE

### 1.1 Object of Service:

The SERVICE relates to services in the area of „Scheduling-Automation Engine/Scheduling UC4“.

### 1.2 Purpose, Scope and Type of the Service:

The parties agree on the type and scope as well as the exclusive purposes of the commissioned data processing of the data by the contractor as follows:

In addition to the Platform Service and the SAP Service, clients often require automatic control of their batch processing. The contractor provides the client with the provision and operation of the UC4 scheduling system in the contractor's data processing centre.

The contractor provides all services necessary for the proper operation of the UC4 Scheduling Service. The services include the following data processing according to the service description

- Setting up a client in UC4
- Hosting and operation of a platform for processing the relevant reports at the contractor's data centre
- Support by the contractor

### 1.3 Type of Data:

Commissioned Data Processing relates to the following types of data:

In any case, the following categories of data can be processed (e.g. when creating the UC4 client)

- Master data (e.g. name, first name)
- Contact details (e.g. email address)
- Business information (e.g. department)
- User rights in the system
